CARBOHYDRATES

PAN-FRYING RETAINS MORE FAT WITHIN THE MEAT, INCREASING CALORIE AND FAT INTAKE. USING MINIMAL OIL AND DRAINING EXCESS GREASE CAN HELP MANAGE FAT CONSUMPTION.

BOILING AND SIMMERING

THESE METHODS ARE LESS COMMON BUT CAN REDUCE FAT CONTENT AS FAT IS RENDERED OUT INTO THE COOKING WATER, WHICH IS OFTEN DISCARDED.

IMPACT ON NUTRIENTS

HIGH-HEAT COOKING CAN CAUSE SOME LOSS OF HEAT-SENSITIVE VITAMINS, SUCH AS B VITAMINS. HOWEVER, PROTEIN QUALITY REMAINS LARGELY UNAFFECTED. PROPER COOKING ENSURES FOOD SAFETY WITHOUT SIGNIFICANT NUTRIENT DEGRADATION.
